National Records

Well done to **Dan Lynch** who has recently set **2** American records in the **50-59 Lightweight** Category. The first was the **1k in 3:08.8** which beat the old record of 3:09.4. His 2nd was a few days later in the **4 minutes** when he set a new mark of **1238** metres which is **1:36.9** pace.

Well done Dan, 2 great performances....and more to come no doubt!
