The old fool (**Rod Chinn**) was at it again in October breaking the 12 year old British record for 1k and setting a new mark of 3:16.1 in the 60-69 Lightweight category (the "Little Old Men") but was soon put in his place as after coxing him to that his good lady wife **Carol Woodward** sat on her erg and promptly broke the world record in the Womens 60-69 Lightweight category taking a whopping great 17.4 seconds off with a time 3:43.0!

**Isaiah** is only just 15 years old but put in a couple of tremendous performances for us last month in the CTC and Indoor Rowers League so well done Isaiah, a great "clubman" as well a multiple world record holder!

He has every Concept 2 record in the book for 13/14 year olds and will soon be re-writing them as a 15/16 year old...then no doubt continue to do so as a 17 year old and beyond!
